# REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING Tuesday, July 15, 2025 6:00 pm Draft Minutes

Prior to the start of the Lowry City Board of Aldermen meeting on Tuesday, July 15, 2025, East Ward Alderman Jackie Cutler announced she would not be able to stay for a closed session that was scheduled after the regular meeting. With East Ward Alderman Charles Cone absent, the closed session was cancelled due to no quorum of the board to hold the meeting.

## Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance:

Mayor Patricia Landes called the regular session to order at 6 p.m. in the council room at city hall. Board members attending included Cutler, West Ward Aldermen Sean Langston and Shirley Edmunds.

City employees attending the meeting included Water and Wastewater Superintendent Josh Muller and City Clerk John Farrell.

Notice of the meeting was given pursuant to RSMo. 610.020.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Landes.

## Approval of Minutes:

The board reviewed the regular session minutes from June 16, 2025. Langston moved and Edmunds seconded to approve the minutes. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

The board reviewed the closed session minutes from June 16, 2025. Langston moved and Edmunds seconded to approve the minutes. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Bills:

A list of bills was presented for approval.

The mayor noted included in the bills list are two invoices from Wommack Monuments for damage from mowers at the cemetery. One is for a bronze flower vase that was beyond repair and the other to a marker with a large chip out of the side. The replacement vase is \$757 and the replacement marker is \$892. She noted Wommack discounted both items for the city and they are also going to pick-up and reseal three tablets that were knocked over during storms at no charge while out here doing the work.

Langston moved and Edmunds seconded the motion to approve the bills presented and to carry-over discussion regarding the damage from mowers at the cemetery until the August 19, 2025 board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

## Financial Reports:

Financial reports for the month ending June 30, 2025 were presented and reviewed. Langston moved and Cutler seconded to accept the financial reports. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

### Old or Unfinished business:

There was no old business for the board.

### New business:

A. Set a date for the tax levy public hearing-On a motion from Langston and a second from Cutler the board unanimously agreed to hold a public hearing for setting the tax levy on Aug. 19 at 5:45pm prior to regular meeting.

- **B.** Propane bids 2025-2026- Farrell stated there were no bids turned in. It was noted Will's LP gas currently services the city. There was no action taken by the board on this matter.
- C. Bids for tree removal at Lucas and Burdette Streets- The board reviewed four bids received for removal of the tree. On a motion from Edmunds and a second from Langston, the job was unanimously awarded to Gary's All Around Tree Trimming, Appleton City, with a bid of \$2,500. Other bids included Coop's Mowing and Tree Service, \$2,250; Truman Lake Tree and Lawn Care, \$4,000; and C&R Lawncare and Tree Service, \$1,500.

Future of city hosting fireworks display- The board briefly discussed the future of the city hosting the annual fireworks show. It was estimated the cost to the city for this year's show was \$2,500 after receiving \$970 in donations. The mayor stated she would like to see the city host the show again next year and have an area group included to make the event larger due to it being the 250th anniversary of the United States. No action was taken.

## Lowry City Community Betterment update:

No representatives attended with an update.

## Citizen input:

There was no input.

## Department Reports:

*Police Department:* Police Chief Charles Hodges was not in attendance due to scheduled training and vacation. No report was presented.

*Fire Department:* Fire Chief Justin Norris was absent from the meeting. A report turned in noted the department has been busy with medicals, a few car accidents and false alarm calls.

Norris stated new structure gloves were received, but they are still waiting on the new fire hose ordered back in late March. Norris' report noted the department is hosting a vehicle firefighting class Saturday, July 26 from 8am-5pm. The class is put on by MU and will be a certified class. It was also noted the Lowry City Fire Women's Auxiliary will host Christmas July Friday, July 18 at the Lowry City Civic Center. Doors open around 6. Events planned include bingo, silent auction and a live auction.

### Public Works:

During a brief public works report Muller reported a new bulk water sales dispenser was installed. He also reported recent work completed at the south-west lift station.

### Mayor's notes:

Mayor Landes had nothing to add.

### Adjournment of regular open session:

Langston moved and Edmunds seconded to adjourn the regular meeting. The vote was unanimous and the meeting adjourned.

### 2025 TAX LEVY

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED PURSUANT TO MISSOURI REVISED STATUTES, SECTION 94.030, FIXING THE ANNUAL RATE OF LEVY FOR THE 2025 REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CITY, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CITY, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby levied for the 2025 tax year, a tax upon the \$100.00 valuation of all real and personal property within or having its taxable status within the corporate limits of the City of Lowry City, Missouri, according to the last assessed valuation of the said properties fixed by the following purposes, to wit:
  - (a) For General operating purposes authorized by section 94.250 RSMo, a rate of \$0.6293
  - (b) For the maintenance and operation of the city street lights in the City of Lowry City, Missouri, a rate of \$0.1953

These levies are subject to revision based on the levies certified by the St. Clair County Clerk.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The City Council finds that the City Clerk of the City has presented to the City Council the following information:

(1) The assessed valuations by category of real, personal and other tangible property for the preceding year and this year are as follows:

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The City Council finds that proper notice was published containing the information set forth in Section 2 above, and a public hearing has been held regarding the proposed rates of taxes.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Within such time to permit the aforesaid taxes to be extended upon the assessment books, the levy so established herewith shall be certified by the City Clerk and to the County Collector of St. Clair County, Missouri who shall proceed to extend the aforesaid taxes for the year upon the assessment books, in appropriate columns.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.

## SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY OF PROVISIONS.

It is the intention of the City Council that each separate provision of the ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein, and it is further the intention of the City Council that if any provision of this ordinance be declared invalid, all other provisions thereof shall remain valid and enforceable.
